#### A. INTRODUCTION:

SHODH 2016, National level Technical Festival was organized at GIT between 18<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> March 2016.

The main objectives of this event are:

- 1. To Enhance Technical Knowledge of students.
- 2. To provide platform to students to expose their hidden talent.
- 3. To develop overall personality of the students
- 4. To enhance individual/Team workmanship.
- 5. To develop interaction with nearby industries & engineering, junior collages.
- 6. To motivate students to develop new ideas which can help to society.
- 7. To develop management skill of students in different fields.

#### **B. PRE-INAUGURAL FUNCTION:**

A special speech by Dr. Shantanu Chakraborty (Head Technologist, TATA Steel) was organized on 18<sup>th</sup> of March 2016 between 2:30PM to 4:30PM on the topics **"BEING A GOOD TEACHER & BEING GOOD PRESENTER"** for all faculty members.

At the end of the meeting the following points are decide to be carry out for SHODH 2017.

- 1. To prepone the dates of SHODH as end of March is exam period for DTE colleges.
- 2. No other program should be conducted during SHODH so that volunteers can concentrate on SHODH.
- 3. Prizes should be declared earlier, mostly at the time of campaigning.
- 4. There should be one separate committee for documentation work.

- 5. Sponsorship committee should be formed at least two months prior the event so as to reach maximum sponsors.
- 6. SHODH event should be arranged for at least 3 days.

#### J. RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. The committee formation must be done in month of August-September so that preparation can be started as early as possible.
- 2. Sponsorship committee should start working in month of January, because in month of February-March most of the companies have their audit.
- 3. I suggest to assign **two conveners** so they can distribute the work load and can complete the work in minimum time period.
- 4. Also continue to involve the maximum student in the event so that they can improve their management skill.

- 2. Use of blog (shodh2016.blogspot.com) for campaigning and advertisement.

- 5. Total 10 new events were added.
- 6. We tried to make GIT SHODH a known Brand through Registration kit, Momento.
