The students who wish to get the benefit of this scheme will have to carefully fill the online application form through mahadbtmahait portal & submit hard copy along with necessary attested documents upto **25<sup>th</sup> September 2024**.

**Benefit: - Rs.50, 000/- for a year**


#### Eligibility:

- Applicant should have Nationality of India.
- Candidate should be Domicile of Maharashtra State.
- Candidates should have pass SSC from Maharashtra State.
- Applicant should be "Bonafide Student of Institute" and admitted for Professional and Technical course (Diploma / Graduation / Post Graduation Degree) as mentioned in GR
- Candidate should be admitted through Centralized Admission Process (CAP) / Institute Level.
- Applicant should not avail any other scholarship/stipend.
- The Total Annual Income of Family / Guardian should not be more than 8 Lakhs.
