
Following suggestions were given by alumni:

4. Common suggestion is to certify the students with international certification courses to get the opportunity

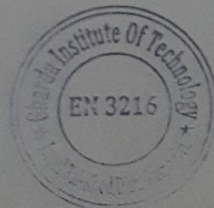
Action taken:


1. Students encouraged getting the real time problem for their mini project and the major project.

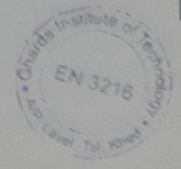
