Type of Participants:

Individual / Max 2 members.

Entry Fee:

Rs. 50/- for Individual Participation

Format of the Poster:

- The poster must be made on the A3 size (11.7*16.5 inches) sheet with margins (0.5inches).
- Poster can be made using pencil, crayon, water colour, oil paint etc. Photographs, wires, other 3D objects, print-outs won't be acceptable.
- Poster should be original and handmade.
- The Topic of the poster and theme should be mentioned at the Top Margin of the poster.
- Poster should not contain any personal details like Name, Class, College etc. of the participants. These details should be mentioned in the registration form only.
- Language to be used in the poster: English
- There is a freedom to select the topic for the poster but it should be relevant to the selected stream.

Guidelines for Event:

- The poster should be present with participant softcopy is not allowed.
- Language of presentation: English

Judgment Criteria:

- Delivery of presentation and relevance to the topic
- The neatness of the poster
- Response during Q & A
- The originality of the poster

Type of Participants: Individual / Group Max 2 members.

Format of the Poster and Guidelines for Event:

- Poster should be related to technology.
- Poster should be presented on A2 sheet that is 420 mm x 594 mm.
- Border should be of 1.5 cm.
- Title should be placed at Centre top position with font size of 130.
- Font size for wording, bullet should be lie between 70 & 90.
- Images should be less than 20 cm x 20 cm.
- Number of images to be used should not exceed more than 4.
- Line spacing should be 1.

Special Instructions –

- a. For copyright images/ graph source of site has to be mentioned.
- b. Pictures/ graph should not be used from Google/ Wikipedia.

Language to be used in the poster: English

At bottom things to be mentioned – Left bottom- Academic Year Middle bottom-Name of the Participants Right bottom- First Year Engineering

Instruction for Event:

The poster should be ready 2 days before Presentation.

Same size printed flex are also allowed.

Language of presentation: English.

For Visitors at least one group member should stay at Poster location.

LAN GAMING:-

Type Participants:- Group of 4 player (+1)

substitute

Entry fee :- 50 Rs. Per student

Player Guidelines:

- It is a 4(+1) player team tournament.
- A 4 man-starter roster and up to 1 substitute.
- Emulators & ipad/tablets are not allowed in any game mode organized.
- The player will be disqualified if found using any kind of emulator.
- Keep Miramar and Sanhok map downloaded in the devices.
- Any game modifying tools except 'GFX tool' is not allowed.
- Any use of unfair means such as aimbot, trigger bot, ESP will be disqualified.
- Should a team/player fail to join the room in time, their squad/they will be given 0 points for it.
- Waiting time is at most 10 minutes between games.
- For the tiebreaker of the points, total team kills will be considered for breaking the tie & for the further tiebreaker, number of chicken dinners will be considered.
- Organizers would not be held responsible for connectivity issues on the participant's side.
- Participants are requested to remain ready at least 15 minutes prior to the start of any match. Late entries would not be allowed.

Startup Idea

Ø Participant Eligibility:

Open to All streams of Diploma & Degree Students of Technical / Non- Technical.

No of members per group: Maximum-4, Minimum-1.

Topic: Any topic which is relevant to your field of interest. [Technical or non-technical]

Ø Presentation Round – Business Plan Competition:

- 1) The Round will be planned as in-person presentation/pitching round and will be a part of the Business Plan.
- 2) All team members need to be in attendance during the pitch session.
- 3) Each team will be given 7 minutes to pitch in front of the jury panel and the audience. There will be 3 minutes reserved for the jury Q &A. Jury will evaluate and score the pitches and select the Winner.

Ø Evaluation criteria for Qualifying and Presentation:

- 1) Significance of the identified problem and relevance/viability/feasibility of the proposed solution or the business/ product/solution/service idea.
 - 2) Reason/s for starting the business and practicality of the business objectives and plan
 - 3) Target market and value proposition.
 - 4) Secondary and primary research and analysis to support the business plan
 - 5) Understanding and clarity with respect to Business Model elements
 - 6) Clarity of thought, expression and creativity in the Business Plan Presentation/Pitch Deck including info graphics Creativity in pitching.
 - 7) **Pitch should include:** 1) Problem statement 2) Proposed Solutions 3) market analysis 4) Business plan
- 5) GTM (Go-to Market) 6) PMF (Product Market Fit) 7) Conclusion

Ø Rules & Regulations:

- 1) Business plans may be presented by individuals or by teams.
- 2) The organizers retain the right to disqualify any team from the Competition if the rules are not observed or if a team does not maintain proper standard of conduct in the professional and collegial spirit of the Competition.
- 3) Please note that the decision of the organizers is final and not subject to review.
- 4) Give title or name to project. You can keep poster of the same which will represent your scheme of project (if needed).

- 5) The explanation can be delivered In front of each visitor and judges (Presentation through PPT is appreciated).
