2. Activities...

- 3 Days workshop on "Applications of GIS & RS in Civil Engineering", 22-24 Sep. 2022
 - A Three Days workshop on "Applications of GIS & RS in Civil Engineering" was arranged from 22nd to 24th September 2022 by the department to enhance the knowledge of GIS & Remote sensing amongst the students. The workshop was coordinated by Prof. V. R. Kasar. This workshop focused mostly on the basics and applications of the GIS system. Prof. Dr. Vidula Swami, KIT, Kolhapur delivered a session on automatic watershed delineation and assessment. Dr. Biswajita Mohanty from VIT Vellore delivered an online session on use of remote sensing techniques for various environmental and water



resource assessment parameters. Dr. Y. R. Kulkarni delivered other sessions and hands-on training sessions for the rest of 2 days. Around 45 students attended the workshop and benefited.

Rural Water Supply Training Workshop, 24-25 April 2023



 A two day workshop on Rural water supply system assessment was carried out by the department of Civil engg. GIT in association with CTARA, IIT Bombay from 24-25 April 2023. The workshop was focused on the RWS scheme assessments from Ratnagiri district and several faculty members and students were part of this assessment. The workshop was enlightened by the team of

CTARA IIT Bombay and they thoroughly discussed the plan of action. Around 47

participants including three final year project groups (around 12 students), 2 alumni and 6 faculty members benefited from this workshop.

AMPSA-2023, 23-25 March 2023

 The institute had arranged a 3 Day national level conference on Advances in Materials and Processes for Sustainable Applications (APMSA-2023) from 23th to 25th March 2023. The conference was arranged with the aim to inculcate the R&D culture amongst the students and faculty members of GIT. The department faculty and students have submitted abstracts and presented papers.



Workshop on Structural design using E-Tab & RCDC software, 26 June-6 July, 2023

 Two week workshop on Structural design using E-Tab & RCDC software was organized on 26 June-6 July, 2023 by department. This workshop was focused on the detailed hands on experience of E-Tab software to students and faculty members. The workshop was carried out by Software Academy For Civil Engineers (SACE), Pune. Mr. Divanshu Parnami, Director of SACE directed students about the applications and usefulness of the structural softwares and their future prospects. The workshop was of total 60 hours and around 70 students have participated.

• NAAC Accreditation with A grade in 2nd Cycle

 The institute is accredited by NAAC with A grade (3.22 CGPA) for the 2nd cycle in January 2023.
